

Make a Bird Cake!

What you'll need:



Bird seed



Suet or lard



Cookie cutters or a
small plastic
plant/yoghurt pot

If using cookie
cutters, you will
also need a tray
and some baking
paper



Scissors and twine

How to make your bird cake:

Step 1

Combine your
lard and seeds -
you can heat this
up on the hob, or
just use your
hands.

Step 2

Once mixed in well, spoon or
squish your mixture into your
mould.

For a cookie cutter you will
want to lay some baking paper
on a tray and then make the
cakes on top of the paper.
You can also use a plastic plant
pot, yoghurt pot, or even a
pinecone as an alternative!

Step 3

Add a piece of twine to
your cake so that it can
be hung up.

If using a pot, you can
poke a hole in the plastic,
or remove the cake from
the mould.

Step 4

Allow your cakes to
cool and become solid.
Hang up in an outside
space and watch for
visiting wildlife!



Tip:

If using a yoghurt/plant pot, you can add the hole and
string before filling with your mixture.
Vegan lard can also be purchased from most
supermarkets if you'd prefer.
