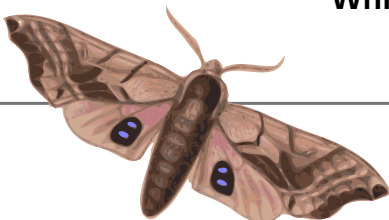


Nocturnal Animals Quiz

1	True! While there are lots of “diurnal” bat species around the world, we only have nocturnal bats in this country.

3	Toads are POISONOUS! They produce a chemical in their skin called “bufo toxin” to poison potential predators
4	c. Dog They are the only wild member of the dog family in our country!
5	b. 5 Barn, tawny, little, long-eared and short-eared owls can all be found in the UK

7	True! Tennis balls are being used as artificial nests for this threatened species
