

Make a Flying Bird!

What you'll need:



The inside tube of a loo roll



Coloured pens



Sellotape



A sheet of A4 card



Scissors

How to make your flying bird:

Step 1

Draw out the features of your bird onto your card. This includes a head, wings and tail. Don't worry about making it perfect at this point because you can go over the lines with your coloured pens later!

Step 2

Colour in your features using your pens. Try to focus on all the colours hidden in the feathers. For example, our pigeon has purple and green in its neck feathers.

Step 4

Cut a 1cm line into the loo roll tube, and a half cm line into the 'neck' of your bird - now you can slot in the head. Attach the rest using your Sellotape, and have fun flying!

Step 3

Cut out the features of your bird using your scissors carefully - you can also cut off any colour that went over your lines if you wanted to make it tidy.



Tip:

In your friend group, why not try making a bird each and having a race to see who the king or queen of the skies really is?
