 Understand problems in our local community Be able to contribute positively to the local environment Be able to contribute to reason discussion about why people may behave in a negative way Work as a team to make decisions Be able to contribute positively to the local environment 	Introduction The class will have a brief welcome and introduction to the day. Activities – depending on the site. Take an interactive walk to discover the impact that people and wildlife have on our parklands. Depending on the site, weather, time of year and group size activities can include -Litter pick competition -Discussion on water safety -Dogs- waste, trampling, sheep -Damage and graffiti -Coppicing: tour of a coppiced site at different stages – learning how to safely use loppers and tools to help lop either hazel or willow plot -Strip the poles of their leaves. Decision making game coppicing game -Squirrel and deer damage -Illegal encampments -Feed the birds and make bird seed cake to take away.	To include: students contribution to discussion before, during and after the visit. Completion of tasks and photographs which you may take for post visit discussions, displays and activities.
