# Open Morning Pre-Visit Guide

Helping you to access our educational activities

### 1. Information

# 2. Coming to the Open Morning

- There is free parking (including accessible spaces) outside the Education Centre in the car park off the H7 (opposite Westcroft).
- There are also some EV chargers here.
- The nearest bus stop is at Hidcote Drive (served by number 8 and number 9 buses)
- Taxis can drop off in the Education Centre car park.



## 3. Arrival

- When you arrive, there might be a purple gazebo outside the Education Centre. Here you can meet Open Morning staff and volunteers.
- The friendly team will direct you to different activities.
- If there is no purple gazebo, enter the building through the glass door, near the sign that says "Grounds Café"



#### 4. Activities

- Some activities are free and some need to be paid for, such as bug hunting.
- You can book activities in advance via The Parks Trust website <u>www.theparkstrust.com/events</u>
- Or you can pay on the day.
- There are free activities inside the Education Centre.





# 5. Bug hunting

- If you book a bug hunting kit, please collect this from the purple gazebo outside.
- The staff and volunteers will tell you how to use it and how to identify what you find.
- Be prepared to find different types of insect.
- Be careful not to touch the insects with your hands as it may harm them. You can use the paintbrush to gently push them into the observation pots.
- Bug hunting sessions last for 40 minutes. Please return your kit at the end for another family to use.



#### 6. Indoor activities

- Inside the centre you can find out about wildlife in Milton Keynes. There are interactive things to see and do.
- Go through the glass door and turn left.
- Staff will tell you which things you can and cannot touch.
- The centre is wheelchair accessible.



#### 7. Facilities

- Inside the centre and straight ahead are accessible toilets.
- The main room with activities in is inside and on the left.
- Grounds Café is accessible via the outside entrance. Go around the terrace and enter via the main door.
